

PROJECT BOUNDARY






VISION




CONCEPTUAL TRAIL LOCATION




TRAIL SURFACE OPTIONS

Which do you prefer?

SURFACING	INITIAL COST	MAINTENANCE COSTS	AESTHETICS
ASPHALT GOOD FOR BIKES & STROLLERS	\$	Requires surface treatment every 5- 10 years	Most closely resembles the current trail
DECOMPOSED GRANITE GOOD FOR RUNNERS	\$\$	Requires surface treatment & rehabilitation	Blends in with natural surroundings
CONCRETE GOOD FOR BIKES AND STROLLERS	\$\$\$\$	Very little maintenance costs	Significant visual impact due to light color



Which do you prefer?


Managing pedestrian access to the bluffs is vital to maintaining their longevity. Fencing and native vegetation will help keep the park healthy for years to come.












POPLAR BEACH ENTRANCE

Entry area will have entry gateways, restrooms, trash and recycling, bike racks and bike station, improved pedestrian trail, beach access and overlook.




GATEWAY FEATURE OPTIONS
