1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER**

2 This Court, having considered Respondents City and County of San Francisco and the San
3 Francisco Public Utilities Commission's ("Respondents") Return of the Writ of Mandate issued by this
4 court on January 28, 2022, wherein Respondents were directed to:

5 1) Immediately commence the process at Calaveras Reservoir required by Health and
6 Safety Code § 117045, to determine if opening the reservoir to public fishing will or will not affect the
7 purity and safety for drinking and domestic purposes of the water collected in the reservoir, and to
8 determine if there are terms and conditions upon which public fishing may be conducted in the
9 reservoir and on its surrounding land;

10 2) Complete such process within 6 months after service of said writ;

11 THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

12 1) The Court finds that Respondents have complied with the Writ of Mandate issued by
13 this Court on January 28, 2022.

14 2) The Writ of Mandate issued by this Court on January 28, 2022 is discharged in its
15 entirety.
