SUBJECT: General Manager's Activity Report

1. Correction to October 19, 2022 OneShoreline Staff Report. The SMCHD, specifically, the General Manager, was notified in December of 2021 of the coastal study. In response, the Harbor District informed OneShoreline that the SMCHD looked forward to working with OneShoreline on the study. OneShoreline did not respond to our request regarding the District's assistance during the study itself.

The next contact from OneShoreline on the study was on September 7th, 2022 at a meet and greet meeting between the General Manager of SMCHD and the Executive Director of OneShoreline. At this meet and greet, the Executive Director presented the results of the study. OneShoreline did not provide a copy of the study itself or the PowerPoint presentation as was requested by the General Manager of SMCHD.

2. Received several emails in support of the Holiday Lighted Boat Festival at Pillar Point Harbor. Responded to each stating based on budgetary and staffing issues, the Harbor District will not host the Holiday Lighted Boat event this year. The District is looking forward to hosting it in 2023.

3. On September 17, 2022, met with Len Materman of OneShoreline prior to the Board Meeting of October 19^h to discuss the presentation.

4. Attended the California Clean Boating Network meeting with the following presentations:

anyone to become a citizen scientist and help (Danielle Tentschert, Education Manager, Ocean Connectors).

- d. Expired Marine Flares in California (Vivian Matuk, California State Parks and California Coastal Commission, Yalin Li, California Product Stewardship Council and Cristian Centeno, Port of Los Angeles).
5. Attended meeting with Noah Katz, Resource Conservation District to discuss Sewer and Stormwater runoff.
6. Attended meeting with Michael McCall, Director of Benefits, OE3 on 2023 contribution rates.
7. Attended meeting with Deborah Hirst to further discuss the Migrating Mural at Pillar Point Harbor and the collaboration with Hatch Elementary School's mural as a part of Oceans Week in 2023. The project involves the Greater Farallones Association who submitted a grant proposal for \$141,000 to support the mural at Pillar Point Harbor. This grant, if approved, would fully fund the update to the interpretive signs at the Harbormaster's Building area near the pier and also cover themed mural work on harbor buildings.
8. Attended meeting with Moffatt and Nichols to discuss Pillar Point Harbor as a base of support for vessels supporting the development of offshore wind in California. Pillar Point Harbor is one of many ports/harbor being considered for the support vessels home port.
9. Met with Philip Vitale of South San Francisco to discuss design update for landscaping and paving improvements at Oyster Point on land managed by the Harbor District.
10. Attended SMCHD Human Relations Committee Meeting.
11. Met with Matthew Chidester, City Manager, Half Moon Bay to discuss maritime search and rescue, capital improvement projects, and district operations.
12. Provided tour of Pillar Point Harbor to Mike Callagy, County Executive Officer, San Mateo County and discussed maritime search and rescue, as well as current and planned capital improvement projects.
