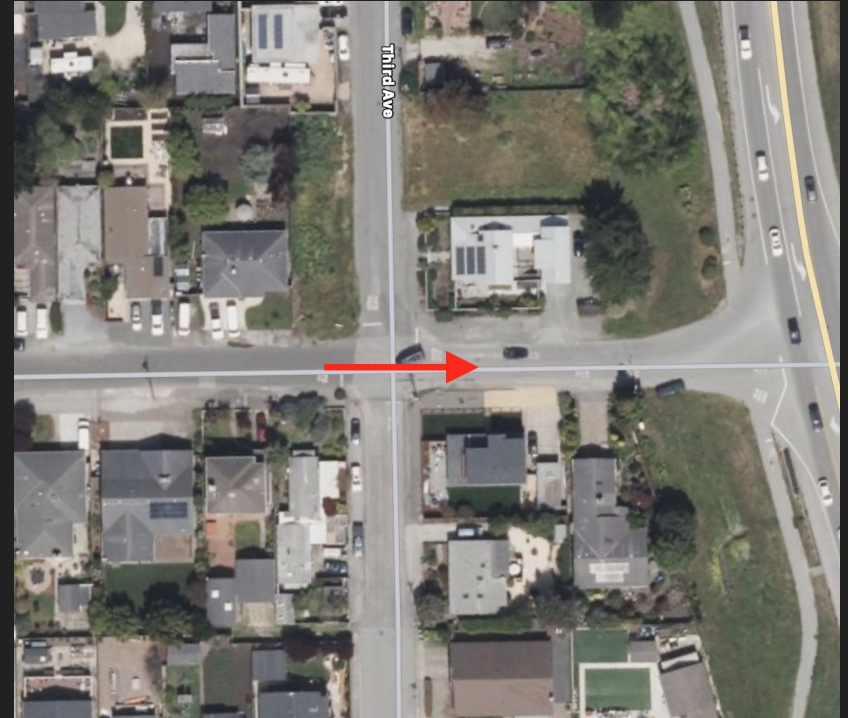

Walk Audit Recommendations: Fast, Cheap & Effective

Recommendation #1: Install Zebra Stripes

Recommendation #2: Install School Zone Signage

Recommendation #3: Landscaping Enforcement/Maintenance



Recommendation #1: Install ZEBRA Stripes at Intersections

- Warn drivers of pedestrian cross traffic
- Warn drivers of pedestrians waiting to cross
- Remind drivers they must give right of way to pedestrians
- Remind pedestrians to check for cross traffic
- Remind pedestrians to stay on the side and out of middle of street



Example: Poplar St and 3rd Ave

Install ZEBRA stripes: **Necessary Intersections**

- Poplar and 3rd
- Spruce and 3rd
- Filbert and 3rd
- Myrtle st and 3rd
- Granelli and 3rd

Filbert and 3rd, Northbound on 3rd
