





U.S. Seasonal Drought Outlook Valid for November 16, 2023 - February 29, 2024


Drought Tendency During the Valid Period



El Niño Southern Oscillation (ENSO)










Model Predictions of ENSO from Nov 2023











EL NIÑO EVENTS (DJF): PRECIPITATION












































Other Winter Threats: King Tides




King Tides Return

- December around Christmas
- January 10th thru 13th

<u>Impacts</u>

- Main impacts will occur along the immediate coast and bay front, as well as coastal marshes and sloughs
- People visiting beaches may lose entry/exit to coves and narrow beaches
- Mariners may experience issues with shallow water at low tides











Other Winter Threats: Coastal Flooding/Erosion




- Low lying area near lagoons, bays, and open ocean at greatest risk
- High surf and storm surge exacerbate
- High tides can exacerbate
- Excessive rainfall at high tide can yield a deformation zone at river mouths

Increasing Confidence for Widespread Wetting Rain Sunday-Monday; Colder Temperatures Midweek

Hello partners! An unsettled weather pattern will bring a few rounds of rain to the Bay Area and Central Coast. The first round of rain starts this evening across the North Bay, spreading south through Sunday. Another round of rain follows shortly behind arriving late Sunday into Monday. Lingering showers into Tuesday. By midweek, cold air will funnel in, resulting in cooler nights. Patchy frost will be possible for the N Bay valleys and southern Monterey and San Benito counties midweek.

KEY POINTS

- Rain will arrive to the North Bay this evening and will spread south tonight into Sunday.
- More rain arrives late Sunday into the North Bay, spreading south again into Monday.
- Cold air will funnel into the area midweek, bringing colder temperatures across the region. Colder morning temperatures expected with potential for patchy frost in the N Bay Valleys and southern Monterey/San Benito counties.
- More rain possible at the end of the week.




