# Methodology for GO Bond and Parcel Tax Surveys

#### RANDOM SURVEY OF LIKELY VOTERS CONDUCTED IN OCTOBER 2023

#### **GO BOND**

- Surveys dates: 10/11/23 and 10/16/23
- Languages: English and Spanish
- Completed surveys: 173
  - ▶ 49% cell phones
  - ▶ 38% text-to-web
  - ▶ 8% email-to-web
  - ▶ 5% land lines
- Average length: 13 minutes
- ► Margin of error: 7.5%

#### **PARCEL TAX**

- Surveys dates: 10/23/23 and 10/26/23
- Languages: English and Spanish
- Completed surveys: 175
  - ▶ 55% cell phones
  - ▶ 28% text-to-web
  - ▶ 10% land lines
  - ▶ 7% email-to-web
- ► Average length: 12.1 minutes
- Margin of error: 7.4%





### Community's Most Important Asset





### **Quality Schools Increase Property Values**










### \$130 MILLION BALLOT LANGUAGE (WITH SCHOOL NAMES): (BEFORE INFORMATION)


If the election were held today, would you vote "yes" to approve or "no" to reject the measure?

"With funds that cannot be taken by the State and spent elsewhere, shall Cabrillo Unified School District's measure to improve student safety; renovate classrooms and facilities; construct teacher/staff rental housing; and ensure handicap access at Half Moon Bay High, Cunha Intermediate, Alvin Hatch Elementary, El Granada Elementary; Farallone View Elementary and Kings Mountain Elementary schools be adopted, authorizing \$130 million of bonds with levies below 6 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation (raising \$8 million/year while bonds are outstanding), with legal rates, citizen oversight and full public disclosure of spending?"






### IMPACT OF SPECIFIC PROJECTS (TOP 5 BY MORE LIKELY + NO DIFFERENCE – YES)








#### **GO BOND - TAXPAYER PROTECTIONS (TOP 5)**






### **GO BOND - TAX RATE SENSITIVITY**




If the election were held today, would you vote "yes" to approve or "no" to reject the measure?

"With funds that cannot be taken by the State and spent elsewhere, shall Cabrillo Unified School District's replacement of its current annual parcel tax be adopted at \$185 per parcel for 8 years (raising \$2 million annually) to recruit and retain qualified teachers and staff; improve academic initiatives for English language learners; and enhance career and technical education/college preparation programs at Half Moon Bay High, Cunha Intermediate, Alvin Hatch Elementary, El Granada Elementary; Farallone View Elementary and Kings Mountain Elementary, with senior citizen exemptions and full public disclosure of all spending?"






### IMPACT OF PARCEL TAX PROJECTS (TOP 5 BY MORE LIKELY + NO DIFF – YES)






#### **PARCEL TAX - TAXPAYER PROTECTIONS**






#### PARCEL TAX - TAX RATE SENSITIVITY
